As we step into the new academic session 2026–27, we look forward to strengthening our partnership with you in nurturing confident, responsible, and well-rounded individuals.

The new session will commence as follows:

- ***Classes I to X: 6th April 2026***
- ***Prep. Junior & Prep. Senior: 8th April 2026***
- ***Classes Play & Nursery: 15th April 2026***

We request you to kindly note the following important guidelines:

1. SCHOOL TIMINGS

Summer Timings (April to October):

- ***Play & Nursery: 08:45 am – 11:30 am (April & May)***
- ***Play to Prep Senior: 08:45 am – 12:30 pm***
- ***Classes I to X: 07:45 am – 01:45 pm***

Winter Timings (November to March):

- ***Play to Prep Senior: 09:15 am – 01:00 pm***
- ***Classes I to X: 08:15 am – 02:15 pm***

Note:

- Holiday List for session 2026-27 is printed in student almanac
- School will remain closed on Second and Fifth Saturdays for students.
- Other Saturdays will be full working days.

2. SCHOOL UNIFORM & DISCIPLINE

- Uniform must be neat, complete, and worn with pride.
- House uniforms to be worn on all working Wednesdays and Saturdays.
- Four Houses from Class 1 to 10: Tulips (Red), Carnations (Green), Daffodils (Yellow), Orchids (Lavender).
- Proper grooming is expected:
 - Boys: Short, tidy hair
 - Girls: Neat braids/ ponytails

3. BOOKS & ACADEMIC RESOURCES

- Booklist will be available on the school website.
- Parents may purchase books from any vendor of their choice.
- All books and notebooks must be covered, labeled, and maintained properly.
- School Almanac must be filled and checked regularly.

4. SCHOOL CALENDAR (IMPORTANT FOR ALL PARENTS)

From the academic session 2026–27, the school will follow two separate calendars:

- **Junior Wing Calendar: Pre-Primary, Class I & II**
- **Senior Wing Calendar: Class III to X**

Important Clarification:

Parents are requested not to confuse the calendar with school timings. The school timings for Classes I & II will remain the same as Classes III to X. The difference lies only in the activities, which will be planned age-appropriately for the Junior Wing.

Key Guidelines for Parents:

- The School Calendar is an essential planning tool for the entire session.
- It contains details of:
 - Working days and holidays
 - Assessment schedule
 - PTMs
 - Important school events (inter-class & inter-school)
- Parents are advised to refer to the calendar regularly to stay updated and plan accordingly.
- No separate reminders will be issued repeatedly for events already mentioned in the calendar (except in special cases).
- In case of any unavoidable changes due to unforeseen circumstances, the school will inform parents through official communication channels.
- It is expected that parents will avoid planning personal travel during assessment periods mentioned in the calendar.
- Regular adherence to the calendar will help in maintaining consistency in the child's academic and co-curricular progress.

All parents must carefully go through the School Calendar printed in the Student Almanac to ensure smooth coordination between school and home.

5. CO-CURRICULAR/ EXTRA ACTIVITIES (CLASSES II–IX)

The school strongly believes in the holistic development of every child, where both scholastic and co-scholastic aspects are given equal importance.

- A variety of co-curricular activities will be conducted for students of Classes II to IX.
- These activities aim to nurture inherent talents and provide a platform for students to express their ideas, creativity, and skills.
- Each student is required to choose any **ONE** activity of their interest.
- A **consent form** will be provided and must be submitted to the class teacher/ reception by **Saturday, 4th April 2026**.
- Activity classes will be conducted only on working days, as per the school calendar, and will not be held during holidays or examination periods.

6. WEEKLY TEST SYSTEM (CLASSES I–X)

To strengthen the habit of regular study and consistent academic progress, the school has implemented a Weekly Test System. This initiative aims to promote continuous learning, reduce exam stress, and help students revise and retain concepts effectively. It will also enable teachers to identify learning gaps and provide timely support.

Key Details:

- Weekly Test Day: Every Thursday (on working days)
- The system will run in 3 cycles during the session:
 - Before Mid-Term Assessments
 - Before Post Mid-Term Assessments
 - Before Final Assessments
- The detailed schedule is printed in the Student Almanac
- Syllabus and test pattern will be shared one week in advance with students and parents

11. ATTENDANCE & WELL-BEING

- Regular attendance is essential for academic success.
- In case of absence:
 - Submit a written leave application.
 - Medical leave must include a doctor's certificate.
 - Sick children should not be sent to school.
 - No half-day leave will be permitted.

12. BIRTHDAY GUIDELINES

- Students must come in school uniform.
- No cake cutting allowed in school.
- Distribution (optional): Simple items within ₹20 per child.

13. DISPERSAL & TRANSPORT SAFETY

- Parents must ensure transport vehicles are safe and verified.
- ID Card is compulsory during pick-up.
- School prioritizes safe and secure dispersal for every child.

14. HEALTHY FOOD HABITS

- Encourage nutritious, home-cooked meals.
- Suggested lunch: Chapati/ Paratha + Vegetable + Salad + Fruit.
- Strictly avoid: Junk food (chips, packaged snacks, soft drinks).
- Meal plans (for junior classes) should be followed regularly.
